Broke and in debt, Andy Hanson is unhappy with his life, as is his wife Gina. His younger, less resolute brother Hank is divorced and behind with the child support payments. Andy suggests an outrageous solution: robbing the Hanson family's suburban jewellery store, owned by their parents. The insurance will cover the loss, and the heist will be dead easy since they know the workings of the store. Reluctantly, the desperate Hank agrees - but can't face the task himself, so hires a small time thug, who insists on taking a real gun for the job. Nobody was meant to get hurt, but then nothing that happens was meant to happen and the heist sets off a cascade of disastrous decisions and revelations.

In 1941 Branagan, Michigan, the beautiful Ethel Ann captures the hearts of three young airmen on the eve of going to war; Teddy, Jack and Chuck. It's Teddy she chooses, and they marry in secret on the eve of his departure, with Teddy wearing the ring that symbolizes their promise of eternal love. Teddy makes Chuck promise that if he doesn't come back, Chuck will take care of Ethel. When Teddy's B-17 crashes into Belfast's Black Mountain, Ethel buries the pain in her heart and her mementoes of him behind a wall in the house they built together. When 50 years later a young Irish lad accidentally unearths their ring, it rips open the past, spilling out secrets that Ethel's daughter Marie finds hard to digest.

When superstar escape artist Harry Houdini arrives in Edinburgh on his 1926 world tour with his manager, the long suffering Sugarman, he offers a \$10,000 reward to anyone who can contact his late mother, and repeat what she told him on her deathbed. He is adamant that science, not superstition, should rule the world. The beautiful but deceptive Marie Magarvie has a psychic cabaret act with her young sidekick daughter, the worldly wise Benji, with whom she survives on their combined wits. When Marie decides to take the challenge, she manages to convince Houdini that she is indeed someone special - her likeness to his late mother helps. Houdini, with a wife back home, is taken by her charms, and what begins as a con evolves into a complicated and dangerous affair.

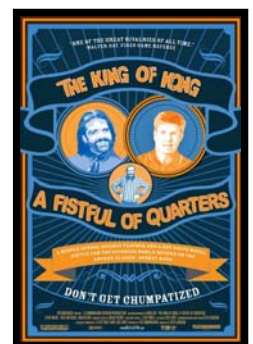
KING OF KONG

THE OTHER BOLEYN GIRL

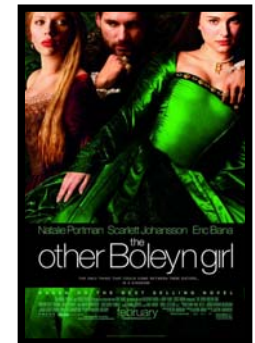
“Two sisters divided...for the love of a king.”

The Boleyn family jewels, Anne and Mary, are the currency that will buy the fading family prestige and financial security - if they are married off to the right people. None is more right than the King of England, Henry VIII, whose Spanish arranged wife Katherine of Aragon has failed to produce a living male heir. Their uncle, the Duke of Norfolk, the master schemer, connives with their father Sir Thomas - under the skeptical eye of their mother Lady Elizabeth Boleyn - to offer the King Anne's favours, with the long term ambition of snaring him not just in the bed but on the throne. But the plan is derailed when Henry falls for Mary and soon England is thrust into internal and international conflict.

THERE WILL BE BLOOD

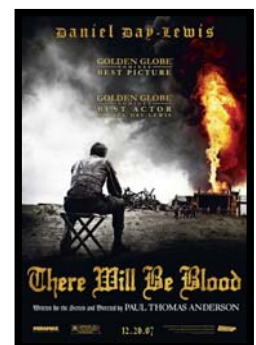
“When ambition meets faith.”

Daniel brings up the orphan HG, as his own, as he buys up ranches where oil may be found - including the Sunday family ranch, where the young Eli Sunday is exciting the faithful & the fearful with his fiery ministry, demanding Daniel be part of it.
