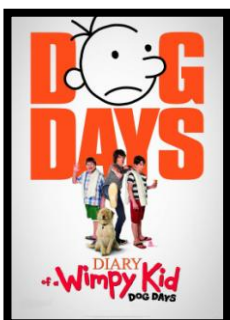

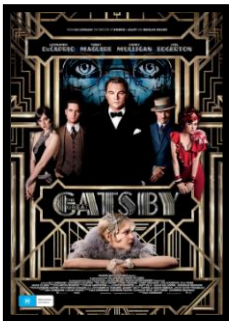


GODDESS

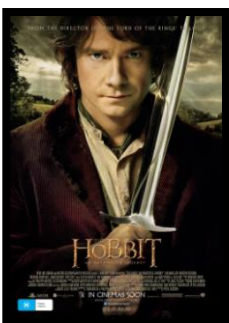


GREAT GATSBY, THE

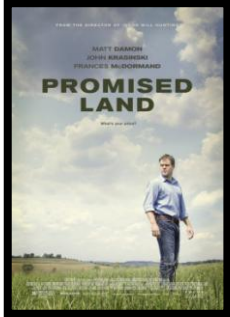


PITCH PERFECT
